Residential Household Waste Disposal

Bagged Household Waste

Each trash bag requires a refuse tag. Visibly place tag on bag prior to disposal.



- Tags cost **\$2.50** each and are sold in sheets of 5. Tag purchases of less than 5 can be made in May and June of every year.
- Tags expire June 30th of each year.
- Tags can be purchased at the RHRTS or South Kingstown Town Hall.
- Bag volume is limited to 35 gallons and weight limit is 35 pounds.

Residential Bulky Waste

A fee of \$0.0775/pound (\$5.00 minimum) will be charged for bulky items such as:

- Furniture
- large household items
- construction/demolition material



Single bulky items weighing 35 pounds or less may be placed in a bag and disposed of with a tag.

Appliances



- Refrigerant (Freon) Appliance: A flat fee of \$19.25 will be charged for the disposal of each refrigerant appliance (this includes refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, etc.)
- Non-Refrigerant Appliance: A flat fee of \$6.30 will be charged for the disposal of each non-refrigerant appliance.

Tires

- Each tire 18" in diameter and under (no rim) costs \$8.00 each.
- Tires over 18" in diameter or greater (no rim) costs \$14.00 each.
- Charge for car tires on the rim cost \$10.25 each.



Additional Materials

- Car Battery - \$2.00
- Clean Mattresses - free, up to 3 per day/Dirty Mattresses - \$85 each
- Motor Oil - \$7 for up to 5 gallons and 4 oil filters

Leaves & Grass

- Yard waste tags may be purchased to dispose of leaves and grass clippings in brown paper yard waste bags.
- Individual yard waste tags may be purchased at the RHRTS or South Kingstown Town Hall for **\$1.25** each.
- Tags expire June 30th of each year
- No plastic bags please.



Residential Yard Waste & Brush

- Large brush, bulk quantities of leaves, tree limbs and trunks less than 6" in diameter may be discharged at a rate of \$0.03/lb (\$5.00 minimum).
- No branches over 6" diameter
- No branches longer than 4 feet in length.

Residential Recycling Guide

Mixed Recycling/ALL In One Bin

Mixed Paper

- Writing and Computer Paper, Phone Books, Magazines,
- Catalogues, Junk Mail, Paperback Books, Wrapping Paper

Newspapers

- All newspapers, ads and inserts

Thin Cardboard

- Cereal and pasta boxes, juice boxes, milk, soup cartons, shoe and tissue boxes, egg cartons.
- **Mostly** clean pizza boxes

Corrugated Cardboard

- Boxes and other corrugated cardboard, brown bags
- Breakdown and flatten larger pieces.

Metal Cans and Foil








- All plastics Containers up to **5** Gallons in Size
- Tubs - Yogurt, Margarine, Plastic Cups and Food Containers.
- Vegetable, Soda, Soup, Coffee Cans, Empty Aerosol Cans
- Clean Foil and Pie Plates

Plastics and Glass

- Jars & Jugs
- Bottles - soda, shampoo, water



Other Residential Recyclables Disposable at the Transfer Station Residential Area

Deposit these recyclable items in designated containers. Books can be donated to the Rose Hill Free Library. Rigid plastics like toys, lawn chairs and furniture can be placed in the Rigid Plastic container. Damaged or soiled **mattresses or box springs** are charged at the rate of \$85.00 per piece. Motor oil disposal is limited to 5 gallons. Residential area trash and recycling is reserved for South Kingstown and Narragansett residents. Proof of residency is required.

RECYCLING DON'TS

Please do **NOT** Recycle any of the following in the Residential Recycling Area or in your Toter or Bin:

- Refrigerated and Frozen Food Boxes - butter, beer, soda or TV dinner boxes (please dispose of in regular trash)
- Household Hazardous Waste - oil based paint, rechargeable batteries, etc. (bring to a local Eco-Depot)
- Sharps - injectables, needles, and other medical waste (bring to a local Eco-Depot)
- **Greasy** pizza boxes (please dispose of in regular trash)
- Styrofoam (please dispose of in regular trash)
- Shredded Paper NOT accepted with recyclables (bring to a local shredding event or RIRRC)
