This survey is intended to be completed by your board as a group, following discussion. While completing this survey please remember that the purpose of this design exercise and public workshop process is to generate feedback in response to the Town Council's request for public feedback on **housing** options for these three properties. Union Studios was tasked by the Town Council to create realistic site layout design concepts for community discussion. While all other options for these properties remain on the table for Council consideration, this specific exercise seeks input on housing, only. Staff stands ready to evaluate other potential uses for these properties in the future if the Council so directs.

On the following pages you will find a table for each site that asks you to Score, Rank and Comment on the proposed design concepts.

- **“Score”** => Assign a grade to each concept on its own individual merit from 1 – 10. (1 = Poor / 5 = OK / 10 = Excellent).
Different concepts on the same site may share the same score.

- **“Rank”** => Rate the concepts against one another in order of preference. (1 = best / 4 = worst).
Different concepts on the same site may not share the same rank.

Please score & rank all of the concepts even if you prefer other uses for the sites. This will allow us to gauge the relative appeal of the concepts. However, if you feel strongly that an alternative use would fulfill a more beneficial function to the community than housing at one or more of the sites, you can check the box in the site name header and explain your preferred alternative and its community benefits in the “Open Comments” block at the end of the table for each site.

- **“Comment”** => Provide feedback on the designs for each site. Several questions are provided to generate consistency in feedback, but feel free to add additional thoughts.

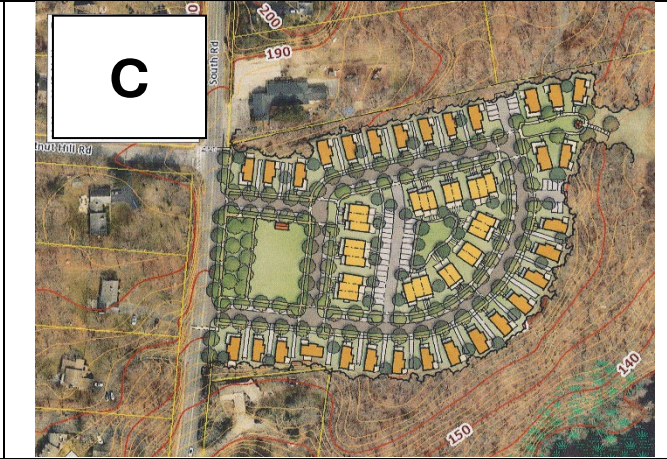
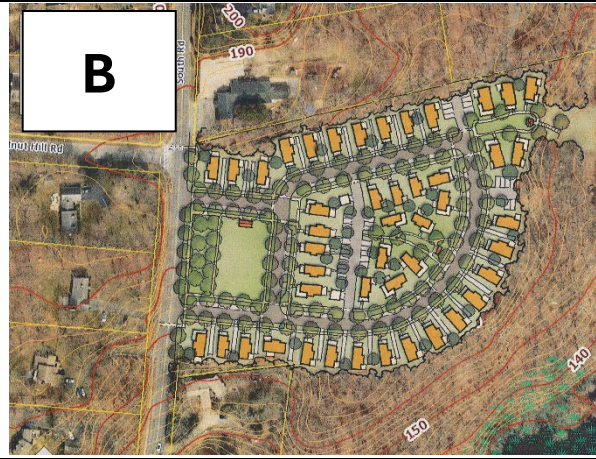
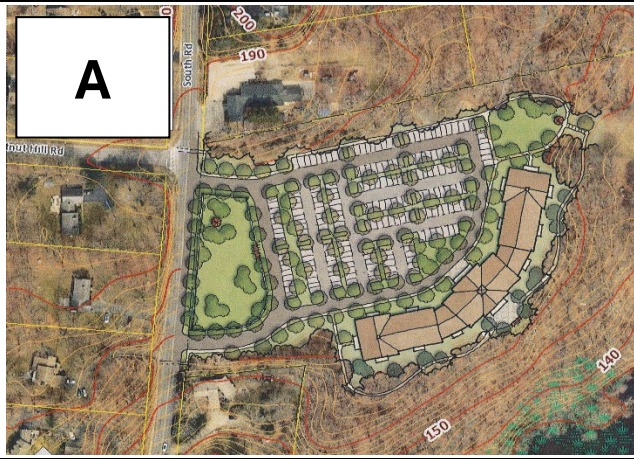
