### **Shelter Opens for South Kingstown, Narragansett and North Kingstown Amid Widespread Power Outages**

*Transportation to shelter must be arranged through dedicated hotline*

The South Kingstown Police Department is advising residents that a regional shelter is open at Broad Rock Middle School to support those impacted by ongoing power outages affecting South Kingstown, Narragansett, and North Kingstown.

In coordination with the South Kingstown Office of Emergency Management and regional partners, transportation and shelter assistance are available for residents of South Kingstown, Narragansett and North Kingstown who may be experiencing unsafe living conditions due to prolonged loss of power or heat.
